**PER COURT:**

1           The Superintendent of State Excise, Ahmednagar, has placed on record communication dated 28.09.2018, informing that there is no insistence on the petitioner -Karkhana for obtaining license to possess or transport denatured spirit for Industrial use and the petition is filed without any cause. It is further stated that in the light of various judgments of this Court, the authorities are not insisting any Karkhana for securing license for possessing or transporting denatured spirit, unless same is found to be misused for potable purpose.

2           It is needless to say that the decision rendered by Division Bench of this Court in the matter of M/s Arss Biofuel Pvt.Ltd. Vs. State of Maharashtra & others (**Writ Petition No.8548 of 2004 & connected matters**) governs the field and the order

passed therein is binding on the authorities.

3           No further direction is needed in view of the communication dated 28.09.2018, which is placed on record and marked "X" for identification.

4           Writ Petition stands disposed of.
