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PER COURT :-

1 The petitioners apprehend an adverse order in pursuance to the notice issued by respondents under Section 79-A of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act. Petitioners contend that the notice itself is bad in law and deserves to be quashed and set aside.

2 At this stage of the proceedings, question of validity or otherwise of the notice need not be gone into and it would be

appropriate for the petitioners to put-forth their reply to the notice. However, we direct respondent Nos.1 and 2 that in the event of issuance of any adverse order in pursuance to the notice dated 10.09.2018 against the petitioners, said adverse order, if any, shall not take effect for a period of four weeks from the date of service of said order on the petitioners.

3 In view of the directions as above, writ petitions stand disposed of.
