Per Court:

1 This matter was not on the Board. It was jointly mentioned and taken on the Production Board for withdrawal.

2 The learned Advocates jointly submit, on instructions, that the litigating sides have settled the dispute amongst themselves and a compromise purshis would be filed before the Trial Court for disposing of RCS No.233/2011.

3 Considering the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.

4 This Court had directed the Petitioner to deposit Rs.10,000/- in this Court for considering his request for carrying out an amendment in the plaint. Now, the parties have settled the dispute and the suit would be

disposed of after the parties submit their compromise terms.

5 As such, the Petitioner is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.10,000/- along with accrued interest from this Court, without conditions, subject to identification by the learned Advocate and on production of the self attested copy of the Adhaar Card and/or Voters Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India.
