ORDER:

1. We have heard Shri. Shahaji B. Ghatol Patil, learned counsel for the petitioner and Shri. P. S. Patil, learned Assistant Government Pleader for respondents No. 3 to 5.

2. Shri. Patil, learned Assistant Government Pleader, on instructions, submits that the Officer had not considered the amendment to the Government Resolution of the year 1979. The Officer would reconsider the claim of the petitioner.
