1. This petition can be disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to take decision on the medical bills submitted by the petitioner for reimbursement. The entitlement of the petitioner for said medical bills or interest at the rate of 12% p.a. as claimed by petitioner, it is for the respondent-authority to take appropriate decision on it.
