ORAL ORDER:

Heard Mr Indani, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

2. It was the submission of the petitioner that in spite of the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court, dated 12th August, 2017, directing the authority concerned, namely, the Investigating Officer to file a report before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Georai within a stipulated period of three weeks from the date of the order, no steps are taken for compliance of the order of this Court and as such, the respondent committed a willful disobedience of the order of this Court.
