1] The applicant has moved this application for
condonation of 24 days delay in filing the appeal against
impugned judgment and award passed by the Commissioner of
Workmen's Compensation in W.C.Case No.21/2012.

2] Heard learned counsel for the applicant and the
respondent.

3] In short, it is the contention of the learned
counsel for the applicant that the delay caused is not
deliberate, but caused due to reasons set out in the

application in detail. It is submitted that due to non-communication of the order by the learned counsel representing the applicant, the appeal could not be filed within time.
