“(A) That this Honourable Court be pleased to grant stay to all further proceeding before the Respondent No.2, in respect of the suit property, for the purpose of adjudicating as to the validity of the Sale Deed, executed in favour of Applicant's pre-decessor-in-title of the Applicant herein by Shri. Kishor Arjun. Mansukhani”.
