1. Heard learned Counsel for the applicant-Insurance Company and learned Counsel for respondent-original claimants.
2. The applicant moved the present application for recalling the impugned order passed by the learned Registrar Judicial-II for dismissal of the appeal for non compliance of office objections notified by the Registry. The learned Counsel for the applicant undertakes to comply with the office objections within a period of two weeks.
