2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicants and the learned counsel appearing for the second respondent. The learned counsel appearing for the applicants submits that a reasonable time may be granted to the applicants to produce the documents as required by letter dated 28th December 2017 issued by the second respondent. He states that he has no objection if this Court directs disposal of the applications by second respondent within a time-bound schedule.
