. By an Order dated 13.01.2017, the Applicants were granted interim relief.

By a subsequent Order dated 12.10.2017, the Applicants were directed to deposit the amount alleged in the first information report in the Registry of this Court.

2 The learned Counsel for the Applicants submitted that the Applicants have complied with the Order dated 12.10.2017 and have deposited a sum of Rs.16,66,000/- in the Registry of this Court. Applicant No.1 is the husband and Applicant Nos. 2 and 3 are in-laws of the first informant Smt. Mamatha Thomas.

3 In view of the above and in view of the ratio laid down by the Supreme
Court in the case of *Arnesh Kumar v/s. State of Bihar*, reported in AIR 2014
Supreme Court, 2756, the Applicants are entitled to be protected by pre-arrest

bail.

4 Interim relief granted by Order dated 13.01.2017 is hereby confirmed, however the condition to attend/report to the concerned Police Station is waived.

5 Application is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
