1. Heard Mr. Tanaji Mhatugade, learned counsel for the applicant and Mr. P.G. Sawant – learned AGP for the State.
2. On 19th September, 2017, Writ Petition was placed for orders before this Bench. This Court directed the applicant to remove the office objections within a period of two weeks failing which petition would stand dismissed without reference to the Court. The petitioner did not remove office objections and therefore, the petition was dismissed for non removal of office objections.
3. The applicant has explained the delay in filing the application.

The learned counsel for the applicant states that he will remove all the office objections within a period of two weeks. Statement is accepted.
