1 This is an application by the applicant/original accused No.15 for renewal of Passport.

2 Heard the learned Advocate appearing for the applicant as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

3 The applicant is convicted by the learned Special Judge for offences punishable under Sections 409 read with Section 109

of the Indian Penal Code and 120-B of the IPC read with Section 13(1)(d) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
