1 The cause for filing the above Petition is the alleged inaction on the part of the police in registering an FIR. The Petitioner has addressed three written complaints which are dated 20th December 2017, 23rd January 2018 and 27th January 2018 to the Inspector of Police, Nagpada Police Station and the concerned Zonal Deputy Commissioner of Police, which have gone unheeded. We, therefore, direct the Senior Inspector of Police,
