Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner in each of the aforesaid petitions, states that his clients would file an Appeal under section 23 of the Maharashtra Slum Areas (Improvement, Clearance and Redevelopment) Act, 1971 before the Appellate Authority within four weeks from today and shall serve a copy thereof upon the contesting

respondents. *Ad-interim* protection granted by this Court on 10th April, 2017 to continue for a period of eight weeks from today. The petitioners would be at liberty to apply for continuation of the *ad-interim* protection before the Appellate Authority. The Appellate Authority shall consider such request on its own merits.

4. If an appeal is not filed by the petitioners within four weeks from today, *ad-interim* protection granted by this Court to stand vacated without further reference to the Court.
