1. On 3rd May, 2018 this Court passed the following order :

“1. Heard Learned Advocates appearing for the parties and the following order is passed by consent :-

i. The Court proposes to appoint Mr. Rohan Nahar, Advocate, having his address at Shanti, 1202/3/20, Off. Ghole Road, Shivaji Nagar, Pune – 411 004 (Mobile No.9822043854) as the sole Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties arising out of the Agreement dated 24th April, 2014.

ii. Advocate Rohan Nahar shall submit his disclosure under Section 11(8) read with Section 12(1) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended by the Arbitration and Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2015 (Act No.3 of 2016).

iii. Advocate for the parties shall forthwith forward a copy of this order to Advocate Rohan Nahar.

iv. All concerned to act on an ordinary copy of this order duly authenticated by the Associate of this Court.

v. *Stand over to 20th July, 2018.*”

2. Pursuant thereto, Mr. Rohan Nahar, Advocate, has submitted his disclosure under Section 11 (8) read with Section 12 (1) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended by the Arbitration and Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2015 (3 of 2016) which is taken on record. In view thereof, the following order is passed :

(i) Mr. Rohan Nahar, Advocate is appointed as the sole Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties arising out of the Agreement dated 24th April, 2014.

(ii) The parties and/or their Advocates shall appear before the learned Arbitrator in his chambers, on 1st September, 2018 at 11.00 a.m. and obtain necessary directions.

(iii) The learned Arbitrator shall endeavour to pass his final Award within a period of six months from the date of this order.

(iv) The learned Arbitrator shall not grant adjournments to the parties unless absolutely necessary.

(v) All contentions of the parties are kept open.

(vi) The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne by the parties equally.

(vii) The venue of Arbitration shall be at Pune.

(viii) In view of this order, the above Arbitration Petition is disposed of.

(ix) A copy of this order shall be forthwith forwarded to the Respondent and their Advocate by the Advocate for the Applicant.
