1. The Recovery Officer Shri Gaurav Dogra, APFC, Pune has filed an Affidavit dated 18.10.2018. Paragraph 1 of the said Affidavit reads as under :

“1. I say that I have withdrawn the prohibitory order under section 8F eing MH/19559/PF/PN/Recovery/35 dated 03.02.2014 passed under the Employees Provident Fund and Misc Provisions Act, 1952 as deemed defaulter in respect of M/s Systech Ltd pursuant to the oral suggestion made by the Hon'ble Court in view of the DRAT's order dated 08.12.2017 in Appeal No. 18 of 2010.”
