2. The Writ Petition is filed invoking jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for transfer of investigation. C.R. No.0062 of 2016 is registered for offences punishable under Sections 304A, 337, 279 of Indian Penal Code and Section 184 and 134 of the Motor Vehicles Act with MIDC Police Station, Taluka-Mahad, District-Raigad.
