2 Advocate for the appellant submits that in the present proceedings, appellant is challenging the judgment and decree dated 18.12.2017 passed by 4th Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune in Marriage Petition No.15 of 2013 under section 13(1)(i-a)(i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for divorce.
