ORDER

- (A) The Applicant is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs. 1,20,000/- deposited in this Court and Rs. 80,000/- deposited in the trial court, total amount of Rs. 2,00,000/-, upon furnishing an undertaking to this Court that if the Revision Application is allowed, the amount shall be deposited in this Court with interest at the rate of 6% per annum.
- (B) The Application stands allowed in the aforesaid terms.
