This is an Application for condonation of 294 days delay in preferring the Revision Application.

2 Mr. Udaipuri, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 1 has filed a detailed reply. He vehemently opposed the Application and submitted that no proper explanation has been given by the Applicant while filing the Application for condonation of delay.

3 However, for the reasons stated in the Application and in

the interest of justice, I am inclined to condone the delay subject to condition that, the Applicant shall pay a costs of Rs.5,000/- to the High Court Legal Aid Committee within a period of three weeks from today.
