The civil application is filed for restoration of the Writ Petition (stamp) No.7349 of 2017. The Petition was placed for order before the Registrar (Judicial-II) on 18th December, 2017. Some of the office objections were raised and the same were not removed. Four weeks time was granted to remove those objections. The Applicants failed to remove the office objections within the stipulated time therefore the petition was dismissed for default.

2. The Applicants have given circumstances in paragraph Nos.3, 5 and 6, under which he could not remove the office objections.
