1. Heard Mr.Akshay Pawar, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By this Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has challenged the judgment and order dated 21.3.2016 passed by the Appellate Bench of the Small Causes Court at Bandra, Mumbai below Exhibit-55 in Appeal No.72/2011.
