By this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India the Petitioner seeks direction against Respondent No.1 to put the Petitioner in possession of an alternate land allotted to him by implementing the order passed by the Collector, Raigad in January 2018 within a time bound schedule (Exhibit-A). He further submits that thereafter he made representations dated 27.02.2013 (Exhibit-C) and 11.03.2003 (Exhibit-D) to the concerned Authority i.e. Collector for allotment of an alternate land.

2 The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has also made representations (Exhibit-E) and 26.05.2014 (Exhibit-G). He submits that all these representations are pending for decision on its own merits with the concerned Authority.
