Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks liberty to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file an appeal under section 35(1-A) of The Maharashtra Slum Areas (Improvement, Clearance & Redevelopment) Act, 1971 against the impugned order dated 31st March, 2018. The appeal shall be filed within two weeks from today and a copy thereof shall be served upon the respondent no.4 simultaneously. It is made clear that no further extension of time would be granted.

2. The Appellate Authority shall make an endeavor to dispose of the said appeal expeditiously and not later than three months from

4. The writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms. There shall be no order as to costs.
