2. By these Applications, the Applicants therein seek Transit
Anticipatory Bail in connection with C. R. No. 93 of 2017 registered
with the Vidhayak Puri Police Station, Jaipur City (South) for the

alleged offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 & 120B of the Indian Penal Code for a period of six weeks to enable the Applicants to take appropriate steps and approach the competent Court of law within the said period. The Applicants are resident of Mumbai and seek transit anticipatory bail to approach the appropriate Court, for filing an appropriate application seeking appropriate reliefs in the aforesaid C. R..

3. Accordingly, the Applications are allowed. The Applicants are granted transit bail for a period of four weeks i. e. the Applicants shall not be arrested for four weeks from today to enable them to approach the appropriate Court for seeking appropriate reliefs, on the following terms & conditions :-

ORDER

(i) In the event of the Applicants' arrest in connection with C. R. No. 93 of 2017 registered with the Vidhayak Puri Police Station, Jaipur City (South), the Applicants be enlarged on transit bail, for a period of four weeks from today, on executing P. R. Bond in the sum of **Rs. 15,000/- each** with one or two sureties in the like amount;

(ii) During this period, the Applicants shall approach the appropriate Court and seek necessary orders.

4. It is made clear, that this Court has not considered the Applications on merits.

5. Accordingly, the Applications are disposed of.
