This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks a direction to the respondent no.2 – Director General of Foreign Trade to dispose of the petitioner's application dated 23rd November, 2016 seeking deletion of the petitioner's name from the denied entry list maintained by respondent no.2 and also on the authorities being satisfied issuing a necessary Export Obligation Discharge Certificate (EODC) in respect of the two Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) licenses.

Mr. Mishra, learned Counsel appearing for respondent no.2 on instructions states that the petitioner's application dated 23rd November, 2016 would be disposed of expeditiously and for that purpose a personal hearing has been fixed on 10th October, 2018.
