- 1 This is a letter through Jail.
 - 2 The applicant is lodged in Sangli District Prison.
- According to the applicant, he seeks bail on compassionate ground. He was absconding. The applicant was released on bail in Criminal Application No. 190 of 2007 in Crime No. 12 of 2007. Thereafter the charge-sheet was filed. The applicant had absconded. That the trial was separated and sessions case was decided by the judgment and order dated 21st August 2017 wherein one of the co-accused Santosh Tevare has been acquitted. However, the Sessions Judge, Sangli has

observed that the present applicant is absconding since beginning and that the police would file a separate charge-sheet against absconding accused Deepak Shevale and Ajit Shivaji Waghmare. Pursuant to this order, the applicant has been arrested. It cannot be said that the court can have any confidence in the applicant that he would make himself available at the time of trial. In view of above, the application stands rejected and disposed of.
