1 This is an application for restoration of Criminal Application bearing No.224 of 2018.

2 Heard the applicant, who is appearing in person. He submits that in Criminal Application No.224 of 2018, notice to

respondents was not issued, and therefore, in the present application there is no need to issue notice to respondent no.1 Priya. The applicant, who is appearing in person, submits that because of his preoccupation in preparation for LL.B Examination, he could not attend the court when the matter was fixed.
