**1]** Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioners and the learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No.2-First Informant.

“(a) That this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to quash and set aside the F.I.R. bearing No. C.R. No.87 of 2018 registered with the Azad Maidan Police Station against the present Petitioners, Urvakash Naval Hoyvoy and Amy Urvaksh Hoyvoy.”

4] It is clarified that, this Order shall not preclude the Police Authority as well as the Trial Court from pursuing the complaint/proceedings against the other accused persons.

5] Writ Petition is disposed off in the aforesaid terms.
