On 30/07/2012 in case no. 403/PW/2011 pending on the file of 37th Additional CMM, Esplanade Mumbai, an application for discharge came to be moved by the applicant pursuant to the provisions of section 239 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. It is informed that neither the charge is framed nor the application for discharge is decided since last about more than 5 years.

2 If the charge is not framed and the application for discharge is not decided, it is expected of the Court to decide the said application for discharge on its own merits without being influenced by this order, expeditiously, in any case within period of four months from today.
