After we expressed our disinclination to grant any relief in writ jurisdiction, particularly when the petitioners agree that they are still employees of the Zilla Parishad, serving it and stand transferred, Mr. Pol, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition. Leave granted. The writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.

2. The petitioners can approach the authority, who has been put in charge of redressal of any grievance of particularly those teachers, who are serving lady teachers, but have been transferred to remote or hilly areas. It is entirely for that

authority to decide any representation or request received in writing from such lady teachers and communicate its decision to the aggrieved teachers as expeditiously as possible.
