1 The Learned APP draws our attention to the letter dated 17-7-2017 of by Shri N. S. Jadhav, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Tardeo Police Station, Division Mumbai addressed to the Petitioner. By the said letter the Petitioner has been informed that the allegations of the Petitioner were looked into and that during the course of the inquiry no evidence has come forward to sustain the said allegations. It is however stated in the said letter that departmental action has been taken against the constable concerned and that appropriate action has been recommended against him.

The said letter
