- 1] Heard learned counsel for the Appellant and respondent.
- 2] This application is filed seeking stay to the execution of the judgment and decree dated 20.01.2018, passed by the Ad-hoc Judge, City Civil Court, Mumbai in Suit No.7588 of 1998.
- 3] It is submitted by learned counsel for respondent that as it is money decree, stay cannot be granted unless the appellant deposits the entire decretal amount.
