1 This is an application for cancellation of warrant issued against the present applicant, who is the respondent/acquitted accused in the appeal filed by the State challenging his acquittal.

2 The learned Advocate for the applicant/respondent in the appeal submits that on admission of the appeal, the action under Section 390 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is directed by this Court and, therefore, the warrant needs to be cancelled.

3 The application as framed and is filed is not maintainable because the Order dated 13th January 2015 passed by this Court directed for action under Section 390 of the Code by issuing a bailable warrant in the sum of Rs.5,000/-. The further compliance is required to be done before the learned trial Court.

4 The application is, therefore, rejected.
