The petition is filed seeking quashment of FIR bearing CR No.102 of 2016 registered with Vimantal Police State, Pune, for the offences punishable under sections 120B, 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 342, 379, 504, 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
