The petition is filed seeking direction to transfer the investigation of FIR bearing CR No. 181 of 2016 registered with Bund Garden Police Station, Pune.

This statement is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner. The grievance of the petitioner is that the concerned RTO as well as Finance Company have not been made accused.
