1. Heard Ms. Deshmukh, learned counsel for the Applicant.
2. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that, within the stipulated time, as the State Government has not sanctioned the amount, as directed by this Court, the same could not be deposited in the Court within the stipulated time. Now the 'Notification', sanctioning the said amount, is issued by the State Government and Applicant will be depositing the said amount within a period of eight weeks from today.
