1] This is an application under section 438 of Cr. P.C for pre-arrest bail in CR No.304 of 2018 registered with Kandivali Police Station, Mumbai under sections 143, 144, 147, 148, 149, 150, 307, 506(2) of Indian Penal Code and under section 37(1)(A), 135 of Maharashtra Police Act.
