

3. From the title of the complaint it is apparent that the petitioners are resident of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan, Karnataka etc.. Learned counsel for petitioners, on instructions, submits that the petitioners would appear before the Trial Court. However, considering the fact that they residing at distant places, sufficient time be granted to appear.

4. In the circumstances, the nonailable warrants issued by the Court of Metropolitan Magistrate, 23rd Court, Esplanade, Mumbai in CC No.1588/SS/2017, as well as order dated 25th July 2018 passed by the said Court rejecting the application for cancellation of warrants, is quashed and set aside. The petitioners are directed to appear before the Trial Court on 6th September 2018 and they shall execute bail bond before the Trial Court. Criminal Writ Petition No.3600 of 2018 is disposed off in above terms.
