2 The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that Respondent filed their Affidavit-in-Reply dated 3.4.2018. He submits that in view of paragraph 4 and 5 of the said Affidavit-in-Reply, Petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the present Writ Petition with liberty to file afresh in case of any difficulty.
