1. Heard Ms. Bajpayee, learned counsel for the Applicant, and Mr. Mendon, learned counsel for Respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that, the Applicant would be depositing the entire decretal amount in the Tribunal within a period of six weeks from today.
3. Hence, the stay is granted to the execution of the 'Decree', subject to deposit of the entire decretal amount in the Tribunal within a period of six weeks from today, failing which the stay to stand automatically vacated without any further reference to the Court.
