1 The above Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction that in the event an adverse order is passed against the Petitioners by the Respondent No.2 in the proceedings under Section 45(A) of the Maharashtra Agricultural Produce Marketing (Development & Regulation) Act, 1963 (for short APMC Act), the same not to be given effect to for a period of eight weeks.
