In these Civil Revision Applications, the order dated 1st July, 2016 passed by the learned 7th Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Thane in respective Regular Civil Suits are challenged.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the issue was decided under section 9A of the Code of Civil Procedure. The

learned counsel submitted that as this is the preliminary issue, the provisions of Section 9A is deleted, thus, Civil Revision Applications abate. He prays that the challenge to the jurisdiction is to be kept open.
