He submits that if such an Application is filed before the Tahsildar, the Tahsildar will decide the Application on its own merits, as expeditiously as possible.

learned counsel for the Petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the aforesaid Petition. The Petition is accordingly disposed off as withdrawn. If the Petitioners file an Application, the Tahsildar will decide the same, expeditiously, on its own merits.
