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was arrested on 14th August, 2018. He preferred an application for bail before the trial Court which was rejected on the same day. The applicant then preferred an application for bail before the Sessions Court which was rejected on 23rd August, 2018.

2. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that applicant is permanently residing at the address mentioned in the cause title of this application. Applicant is willing to give undertaking that he would attend the trial Court regularly on each and every date without fail. The applicant is prosecuted for the offence punishable under Section 326 of Indian Penal Code and the stage of the trial is for recording evidence. It is submitted that he has not left the residence and he is residing at the address mentioned in the cause title of this application.

3. Learned APP submits that applicant has not attended the Court for a long time, therefore, his bail application may be rejected.

4. Taking into consideration the nature of offence, for which he is tried and considering that he is willing to give undertaking to attend the trial Court regularly, bail application can be allowed.

ORDER

i) Bail application No. 2172 of 2018 is allowed;

- ii) The applicant is directed to be released on bail in connection with Criminal Case No. 587/PW/1996 pending before Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, 24th Court, Borivali, Mumbai on furnishing P.R. Bond of Rs.20,000/- with one or more sureties in the like amount;
- iii) Applicant is permitted to furnish cash security in the sum of Rs.20,000/- for a period of four weeks;
- iv) After the release, the applicant shall file an undertaking before the trial Court that he will attend the Court proceeding on each and every date of hearing, unless he is exempted by the trial Court;
- v) Applicant shall produce documents relating to his residential address before the trial Court;
- v) Application stands disposed off.
