2. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant has
already served the unserved respondents by private notice in
compliance of the order dated 23rd September, 2016. statement is

accepted.

3. For the reasons recorded in the civil application, the order dated 23rd September, 2016 dismissing the writ petition for want of compliance of the order dated 23rd September, 2016 is restored to file on the condition that the applicant removes all office objections within two weeks from today. It is made clear that no further extension of time would be granted. If the office objections are not removed within the prescribed time, writ petition to stand dismissed without further reference to court.
