By this application, the Applicant has sought stay of execution and operation of judgment and award dated 18.4.2017 passed by the learned Member, M.A.C.T., Mumbai in Claim Application No.2656 of 2012. By order dated 27.9.2017 ad-interim relief was granted by this Court subject to deposit of the entire decretal amount alongwith interest accrued thereon, within a period of six weeks from the date of the order.
