*1] The Orders dated 20/04/2018 and 25/09/2018
passed by the Hon'ble City Civil Court in Suit No.8506

subject to the Petitioner (Original Plaintiff) furnishing costs in the sum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) to the Respondent (Original Defendant) within a period of 1 week.

2] The Petitioner to make an application to the trial court under O. XVI Rule 1 of C.P.C. 1908 to seek permission to examine additional witness viz. Shri Arvind Bhatia. The trial court to hear both the parties after giving opportunity to the Respondent to file its reply and dispose of the said application on merits.

3] The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed off."
