2. Heard Mr. Keni, learned Counsel for the petitioners, Ms Gavhane, learned AGP for respondents-State and Mr. Karandikar, learned Counsel for the respondent No.2.

4. Mr. Karandikar raised preliminary objection on the ground that the same order was also challenged in the following Petitions and the same were dismissed:

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- (ii) Writ Petition No.4675 of 2014 by Ravindra Babu Dhodi and others was dismissed on 06.05.2014; and
- (iii) Writ Petition No.8661 of 2017 by Navin Gopal Dhodi (decd) through LRs and others was rejected on 31.07.2017.

5. Mr. Karandikar, therefore, submitted that the present Petition is not maintainable.

6. Mr. Keni was not in a position to controvert this position and show that the order passed by the Tribunal was not the subject matter of the challenge in the above Petitions. As the impugned order passed by the Tribunal is confirmed by this Court in three matters, referred hereinabove, I find merit in the objection of Mr. Karandikar. Hence, Petition fails and the same is dismissed.
